

Dear Reverend,


You are being given this because the person presenting it to you would like to have an Ommandala amulet. This amulet is an Ommandala which is encased permanently in plastic (epoxy resin) which can be worn on a necklace. It is my desire to have the Ommandala dedicated and eye-opened by the individual's priest, rather than myself. I have prepared this form for you to use to guide you. The maximum area for you to write is the outside line on the image. The inner line provides you a small margin. Please know that marks outside the image will not be able to be reproduced.

The dedication you write here will be sent back to me by the individual. It is not your responsibility, unless you wish to send it to me instead. Once I receive the written dedication I will reduce it 50% and attach that print to the back of the Ommandala. These two will be encased into the resin and the metal parts for the necklace will be added. When it is completed I will send the item to the person ordering. I am instructing them to then contact you so that you may do the final eye-opening on the item which will have a reproduction of your dedication.

It is my desire to encourage the connection between the person and their temple and priest. That is why I am asking your assistance. If you have any questions please send me an email and I will respond. In closing I thank you for your support and the work you do to care for this person.

Instructions for person ordering Ommandala amulet: It is important that when you print this out to take to your priest you are printing it at 100%. Some printers will resize the image. Usually the print to 100% is not default and needs to be selected when you print. If the image is larger then you risk not having everything your priest writes show in the final product. As a way to verify it is printed at the correct size please measure. If your printed copy is slightly smaller that will be fine. The sizes given are within 1/8" which is acceptable for this. When your priest has completed his work please return this to me. Sending the original is preferred, scanning and sending a high resolution file is also acceptable. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact me for clarification.
